

By-Laws – 3.4 COWTOWN CRUISER CCP

This committee, also known as CCP, was designed to promote cruising in Corvettes with Club members. This is a non-NCCC function. It does have a points system detailed in the Standing Rules, Policies and Procedures. The Chairperson is responsible for the tracking of the annual cruiser points along with acquisition and presentation of annual awards.

Cruiser Guidelines

Timelines:

- **Year Ending (as competition ends):**
 - Cruisers must have their cruiser log sheet turned in by the 3rd Sunday evening (midnight)
 - Cruisers must have their cruiser photos turned in by the 4th Sunday evening (midnight)
 - Validate that each participant's log sheet and photos correlate; contact the participant as needed.
- **Year Ending (after competition ends):**
 - Prior to the end of the calendar year, any suggested rule changes need to be made for the next competition year. This includes the cruiser photo contest which is separate from the full cruiser competition. Typically we met and handled this as a small group of members that cruised the current year, in a short meeting; we have met prior to the December Membership Meeting which worked well.
 - After the meeting, adjust the rules and log form to reflect any changes; getting those forms ready for the next competition year.
 - If T-Shirts are to be utilized, the graphic needs to be finalized and Shirts printed
 - Have the webmaster post the Top three Cruisers, after they have been announced at the Christmas Party and Awards Banquet in December.
 - Have the webmaster post the Photo Contest Winners after they have been announced at the Christmas Party and Awards Banquet in December.
- **Year Ending – Awards:**
 - Present the Photo Contest Winner(s)
 - Present the Participation Awards (Bronze, Silver & Gold)
 - Present the Top 3 Cruiser Awards (typically Gold level)
- **Beginning of Competition Year:**
 - Print Cruiser Sheets and Log Forms for members to start cruising.
 - Promote individuals to sponsor a cruise, even if just a ½ day cruise somewhere for lunch.
