

The Corvette Heritage Tour will be at Convention in Vegas!!

The Corvette Heritage Tour made its debut at the 2000 running of the 24 Hours of Le Mans in France. Corvette C5Rs dominated the podium for the GT Class. Since then, The Corvette Heritage Tour visited the 24 Hours of Daytona, The National Corvette Museum in Bowling Green, Kentucky, and dozens of other locations across the U.S. and abroad.

Over \$100,000 was spent researching, designing, and producing these materials, and now they are available to Corvette enthusiasts.

You will immediately recognize the depth of research behind these works of art. Initial research was conducted by a former editor of Corvette Quarterly. Photograph sources include private collections and the official GM Archives. Many images have never been published,

or haven't been published for decades.

Now, for the first time, materials developed for the factory-backed Corvette Heritage Tour are available for enthusiasts.
