 Entries must be a current Cowtown Vettes member and can be one vehicle per person or couple. Only photos will be accepted. We are unable to accept digital photos printed on regular paper, photos stored on CDs, or slides. Digital cameras may still be used; however, only photos printed on high-resolution photo paper will be considered. A separate photo must be submitted for each point.

A minimum of 26 photos must be submitted to qualify for prizes. Entries MUST include an official 2005 Cowtown Cruisers form, available from the Special Events. ALL OF THE FOLLOWING ELEMENTS MUST BE INCLUDED IN EACH PHOTO SUBMITTED:

- Your Chevrolet Corvette
- A current (2005) Cowtown Low-Down newsletter
- You (the entrant)
- An "official sign" as defined below:
- 2. An "Official Sign" is:
  - A government building with the name of the city / town / county / state / territory or country on it, such as a post office or police station (libraries or schools do not qualify)
  - An authorized Chevrolet dealership may be used to designate a city and state ONLY. However, the first letter of the actual city where the dealer is located is the letter for which you will be credited. (For example: a photo of "Bruce Lowrie Chevrolet" would give you credit for the letter "F" because that dealership is located in Fort Worth, TX.) Photos in front of Chevy dealers must have the name of the dealership appear in the photo, and the name of the city and state written on the back of the photo.
  - A sign posted by a government body, which exists in the boundaries of the place it identifies. (Mileage markers or directional signs are not allowed.)
- The name of the Chevrolet dealership, city, town, state, country, etc. MUST appear legibly on the "official sign" in the photo to receive points. Any illegible photos will not receive points.
- You must DRIVE your Corvette (use rental of Corvettes is acceptable). Photos with Corvettes on trailers ARE NOT eligible, this is a CRUISING PROGRAM.
- 5. Photos must qualify as outlined above to be eligible for points. Points are awarded as follows:
  - One point for each city, town, township, or municipality sign from A-Z. Limit one point per letter (maximum of 26 points).
  - One point for each county, parish, or district sign from A-Z. The word County, Parish, or District MUST appear on the sign as well as the name. Limit one point per letter (maximum of 26 points).
  - One point for each State. The name of the State MUST appear on the sign (maximum of 50 points).
  - One point for each Country. The name of the Country MUST appear on the sign (maximum of 6 points).
  - One point for each Province / Territory. The name of the Province / Territory MUST appear on the sign (maximum of 15 points).

- One point for a National Forest sign. The name as well as "National Forest" MUST appear on the sign (maximum of two points per year).
- One point for a U.S. National Park sign or a Provincial Park sign in Canada. The name as well as "National or Provincial Park" MUST appear on the sign (maximum of two points per year).
- NCCC Event photos as listed below must clearly show an official Sponsoring Club name or the Club Governor's Photo:
  - One point for each 2005 NCCC Event<sup>1</sup> cruised to; in or out of the SW NCCC Region. Extra points for mileage (from downtown FW) will be added as follows:

Miles: 100-299 = 1; 300-599 = 2; 600 & greater = 3

- Five points for cruising to the 2005 NCCC National Convention<sup>1</sup> in St. Cloud, MN.
- Two points for 2005 National Event held outside of the U.S. as approved by the Cowtown Board.
- Two points for each 2005 <u>National Corvette Museum</u> <u>"Corvette" Events</u> as published on their website or their publication of "America's Sports Car" (maximum of ten points per year).
- Two points for each of the following Corvette facilities: <u>National Corvette Museum</u> (NCM) in Bowling Green, KY; <u>Corvette Assembly Plant</u> in Bowling Green, KY (maximum of 4 points per year).
- 8. The following prizes will be awarded.
  - 1st place "Top Cowtown Cruiser" plaque \*
  - 2nd place "2nd Place Cowtown Cruiser" plaque \*
  - 3rd place "3rd Place Cowtown Cruiser" plaque \*
  - 66 points Cowtown Cruiser Gold Level patch.
  - 56 points Cowtown Cruiser Silver Level patch.
  - 46 points Cowtown Cruiser Bronze Level patch
  - \* Also includes above listed awards or prizes given through 66 points (awards/prizes are subject to change).
