





HAVE FUN DOING IT!!!

CTV COMPETITION REPORT

As your competition chair (and a former racer), I realize all too well how expensive it is to compete in autocrosses and/or drag races and there is not much that I can do to help. Heck, I'm just a feeble old man living on a pension during these tough economic times! (I know; whaaaa whaaaaa.) But,..

There is a little bit I **can** do to help. The NCCC rules do not require restraint systems in Groups I or II, but I have learned from actual experience on more than one occasion that the better attached you are to your Corvette, the safer you are and the more successful you will be at cutting a better lap or pass. No, really!! If you have done any autocrossing using only the factory lap belts, you already know how uncomfortable it is to rattle around in the car while negotiating tight turns. And...

I just happen to have acquired two (2) sets of "pre-owned" restraints. Set 1 is a six-point G-Force (red); Set 2 is a four-point Simpson (blue) that only needs a sub strap if you prefer one. Both sets are of the "camlock" design. I will let JANE BUEHLER **give them away** to the person with the winning 50-50 ticket. I realize that cold hard green dollars are always the best prize, but maybe these belts could be a second best prize to someone who wants them. If you do win them and have no use for them, it will not hurt my feelings to decline my offer to make them available for some needy racer. Although you still must acquire the means to attach them to your car, you have at least mitigated the cost of restraints. These belts are the bolt-in type and will require you to obtain some snap-in attachments. I have one set of four (4) snap-in attachments that I will furnish to one of the winners of the restraints. I have never seen new restraint systems priced at less than \$100. These are used, but **not** used up.

While I am in the giving mood, I will also donate some DOT 4 brake fluid (new, of course). I will also donate two (2) cans of ATE fluid (one blue and one gold that works well when completely flushing brake systems; you can see when you are done.) These cans are one liter each (of German origin).




