

## **CAR SHOW COMMITTEE**

CTV's Car Show Committee had its first meeting on May 12 at the Hoaldridges. Notes from that meeting will be distributed to Car Show Committee members shortly. Have you signed up to work on this committee this year? If so, THANK YOU. If you have not, please reconsider. It's not all work...it can be a lot of fun, too. Future committee meetings will be held at Coors once a month. When the dates are firmed up with Coors, I will put the dates on the CTV website and in future issues of The Cowtown Low-Down. The committee's focus is on the Fort Worth Motorama in July and CTV's Annual All Corvette Show in October.

A group of nine members have volunteered to participate in CTV's club display at the upcoming 37<sup>th</sup> Annual Fort Worth Motorama, July 1-3. If you are not one of these members, I hope that you will consider attending the Fort Worth Motorama, July 1-3, to support your fellow CTV members who will be showing their Corvettes in CTV's club display and to enjoy all the cars, trucks, motorcycles, etc. that this Fort Worth homegrown car show has to offer. Remember, CTV has been involved in this car show, either with a club display or a group of members showing their Corvettes, since May 1975.

Mark your calendars for **CTV's 10<sup>th</sup> Annual All Corvette Show -- OCTOBER 15**. More details will be forthcoming. Check future issues of The Cowtown Low-Down and the CTV website.

Have you heard of the Cowtown Car Show Points System? (1) The 2011 show season is January 1 thru November 13, which is the weekend prior to Thanksgiving. (2) Only Corvettes are eligible (no other member-owned vehicle). (3) Participant is a representative of Cowtown Vettes. (4) Points as shown below will be awarded to the car, not the participant.

- Show Entry (per show day, i.e. 3-day car show\* would receive 3 pts) 1-x pts
- Show Award [1st Place (or Top 20, Class Winner)] 3 pts
- Show Award [2<sup>nd</sup> Place (or Class Award)] − 2 pts
- Show Award [3<sup>rd</sup> Place] − 1 pt
- Show Award [Club Sponsor Car Exhibition/Display] 5 pts
- Best of Show -5 pts
- Sponsor or Manager Award − 4 pts
- Best Paint, Best Engine, Best Interior, etc. − 2 pts
- Mileage Points (one way) from downtown Fort Worth (unless you live over 50 miles from CTV's PO Box in downtown Fort Worth) 100-299 miles 1 pt, 300-599 miles 2, 600+ miles 3 pts.

If you have participated in any car shows this year, please let me know. I will report car show stats in future issues of The Cowtown Low-Down, so please provide me with details no later than the 1st of each month.

Don't forget to check out the various car show schedules that appear on the CTV website.







# NCCC Charity & Grants Program

The National Council of Corvette Clubs, Inc. (NCCC) Charity & Grants Program (Program) began in 1975 and has grown steadily, not only in dollar amounts that are given, but also in the area of service. The Program depends entirely on voluntary participation by NCCC Clubs and their Club Members. Through the years NCCC, as an all volunteer organization, has donated over \$1.5 million to the Muscular Dystrophy Association, the Spina Bifida Association of America and the National Kidney Foundation. In 1996, NCCC began working with the National Kidney Foundation in support of their Transplant Games and the Organ Donor Awareness Program.



In 1990 the Program initiated the disaster program designed to assist members during times of financial crisis and/or disasters. Monies raised for the Grants are generated through in house craft sales, a 50/50 raffle conducted at each National Governors Meeting and the dollar raffles held at the annual National Convention.

In 1990, the Program established a Scholarship Program for Members and their children to assist with educational opportunities at the college level. Funds for the scholarships are derived from special gifts from Members, Member Clubs, Regions and Sponsors as well as the dollar raffle at the annual NCCC Convention.

Each year since 1977 the Program has held a raffle for a new Corvette. With the assistance of the Chevrolet Motor Division, a new Corvette for the raffle is purchased with Funds that are raised through the ticket sales. Tickets are sold across the country at car shows, meetings, Corvette events and among friends and co-workers.

NCCC Members and their Clubs are also involved in Charity work across the country. NCCC and its Members have donated many dollars and much time over the years. NCCC is truly a first class giving organization!






