



Cowtown offers a variety of activities for its members and the more you participate the more you will enjoy the club and other members. It is our members that make Cowtown a great club.




COWTOWN CRUISER



The Cowtown Cruiser Program ended May with a cruise to Mississippi and began June with a cruise to Jefferson, TX. Let's keep cruising and enjoying the fun rides in our Corvettes! Your suggestions for the

next cruise will be greatly appreciated. It does not need to be a long, weekend cruise but can be just a day cruise to enjoy lunch or dinner, or to visit that unique museum or shop you have always wanted to visit. I can help you plan a route and offer tips to make your cruise a success.

Thirteen Corvettes and 25 members/guests took the Tail of the Lizard cruise in May. Everyone had dinner overlooking the Mississippi River in Natchez and had time to visit the casino. Friday began with a challenging run of Hwy 587, the Tail of the Lizard, with curves and hills. To make the journey more interesting a Rallye was provided. Seven couples competed and received awards during the Friday night dinner at Magnolia Hall. First place went to Mary Pittman and William Nolan, second place to Bob and Cindy Morrison, and third place went to Robert and Cydnie Geyer. Before dinner we had an exclusive tour of the home and a brief history of the family that lived there. Saturday morning began with a scenic drive along the Natchez Trace Parkway where we walked on a section of the original trace used by Indians and early settlers as a trade route from Natchez to Nashville. We were able to climb to the top of Emerald Mound, the second highest Indian mound in the U.S., and observed some of the local wildlife, a grass snake, resting along the pathway. At Mount Locust we toured the home that started as a farm and became a stand or inn along the original Natchez Trace. We arrived in Vicksburg in time to have lunch, check in at the hotel, and have a private guided tour of the Vicksburg battlefield. Our guide rode with David Gill and talked about the site into David's radio which allowed all of us to hear his information on our radios. We stopped at the Texas monument as well as other monuments for more information. Those that did not take the tour enjoyed shopping or visiting the casinos. After meeting for breakfast on Sunday morning, members left at various times to head back to Fort Worth.



Mark Kirby led a small group to Jefferson, TX to participate in the Big Cypress Corvette Show. In addition to the show they enjoyed activities and dining with fellow Corvette enthusiasts. Our annual pet food drive will be held at the August meeting. Each member is asked to purchase pet food, donate pet food coupons and/ or give a monetary donations. All the food




