The Cowtown Cruiser Program for 2015 has come to an end. I hope you enjoyed cruising in your Corvette, collecting points, and discovering new places on your journeys. Your photos must be submitted no later

than November 15th. After reviewing all of the point's sheets and photos, the verified points will be used to determine the top three competitors as well as those earning bronze, silver, or gold level participation awards. Awards will be presented at the December meeting and at the Awards Banquet.

I have enjoyed being chairman of the CCP this past year but will not be able to chair this program in the near future. Cowtown Vettes will need someone to take over this position for 2016. Donald and I will gladly serve as co-chairmen to help that person learn what is needed to fill the position. If you are interested in serving as chairman please let me or Donald know.

The Cowtown Cruiser Program for 2016 will begin on January 1st. The logo sheet and point's sheet will be available in December. If you are planning on participating in 2016 I would like to offer two helpful items. Last month I mentioned an APP called Markers. This is a great tool to use while traveling so you can find historical markers to maximize the points you get at each stop. In addition to locating the markers, this APP will usually show a picture of the marker or the words on the marker so you can verify that it has the information you need. The other item is a Rand-McNally Road Atlas. You can purchase a spiral bound, large print version that is easy to read. It shows county seats, state/national parks and forests, historical sites, and scenic routes that will help you plan your trips. An index in the back lists all of the counties and cities for each state.

Gwynne Hanna and I are working on the cruise for the Red River Army Depot in March. The dates are March 18, 19, and 20. If you have not signed up to go but are interested in going please let Gwynne or me know as soon as possible. This will be a cabin campout weekend in a very scenic and relaxing area. Those of you collecting points



will have many opportunities to get started on the 2016 program. Bring a book to read, games or puzzles to play, and comfortable walking shoes.

January 1st will also be the start of the 2016 "What I Saw along the Way" photo contest. You do not need the logo sheet to capture your Corvette in interesting or unique places nor do you have to be a Cowtown Cruiser Program participant to enter this contest.
