
75 points to finish at Gold, both very achievable! Remember to keep your cruiser logo and log sheet readily available, don't pass up a cruiser point, if you find one with a higher point value later you can use it instead of having to go back to get one you passed up. As always if you have questions, need a cruiser logo or log sheet please contact the cruiser chairperson and also there is great info on the CTV website.

One of the categories on the cruiser log sheet is Historic Churches (total 9 points). Early settlers to our state brought with them their religious beliefs and set up centers of worship. They were often small wooden structures, some plain and others with stained glass and other embellishments. Almost every community had several churches and many still survive today. Generally a historic marker is your clue that the church would qualify for a cruiser point or in some cases the church denomination may have awarded the church with a plaque or sign recognizing its age and/or historical significance.

By the time you are reading this our first organized cruise of the year to the Red River Army Depot will be history. I am sure those who went had a really fun time seeing the sights and getting better acquainted with some of their fellow members.

For those of you who have signed up for the Swiss America Cruise to Colorado in June, hopefully you have had the opportunity to get your hotel reservations made. Keep an eye on the website for more upcoming information.






MORE FROM THE WALKING TOUR OF FORT WORTH






