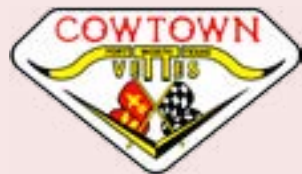

For those of you that are new to the club and/or new to the Cruiser Program, I am going to repeat a portion of our article from the 2016 Low-Down.

## “What I Learned Cruising”

William and I joined Cowtown Vettes in March 2013. The cruiser program seemed like a good place to get involved...no special equipment or skills required, just the car, a camera and the cruiser logo. We later learned a good dose of common sense would be helpful! Cities and counties matching the letters of the alphabet seemed like a good place to start. Later we could add a few parks or historic churches, how hard could it be...so we set out...a city limit sign seemed like a good option, well, not so much if you are on a busy road and you need to get the sign, your car, the cruiser logo and yourself in the picture. First of all, city limit signs are much taller than they appear and cars are passing by much closer and much faster than one would think. So after this activity was determined to possibly be hazardous it was on to plan B. We learned that courthouses could be a bonanza of points with the county name, sometimes the city name, historical markers and veterans memorials.....

The 2018 Cruiser Program is off and running. Hopefully before long we will have some weather pretty enough for cruising...not too cold, not too hot, but just right. The 2018 Cruiser logo, rules and log sheets are available from the Cruiser Chairpersons, William Nolan and/or Mary Pittman. As mentioned above no special equipment is required for this function....the camera can certainly be your cell phone. The photo should include your car, yourself, the 2018 logo, and the official designation for the location. Points can be accrued on individual travels or on club sponsored events. Point totals required to earn an award are 100 for gold, 75 for silver and 50 for bronze. Take a minute to read over the rules to see what will count toward your points total. If you have questions about how to count your points or any other part of the program, please feel free to ask.

There are several cruises in the planning stages for 2018. Gwynne and Gary Hanna are considering the possibility of a return to the Red River Depot near Texarkana. Robert and Cydnie Geyer are working on a couple of great ideas and Becky Clark is looking



into another combination 100%er/cruise with William Nolan. Hopefully Doug and Glenda McMahan will be planning a fun route to get us to the NCCC convention in New Orleans in July.

Also, remember to be on the look out for interesting, scenic or unique settings to capture a photo of your Corvette for the Cowtown Cruiser Photo contest showing “What I Saw Along the Way”. Anyone is eligible to participate in this contest. You do not have to participate in the cruiser program to enter.

The Cruiser Program is a great way to get off the interstate, travel the back roads and see those “jewels” you’ve been missing.

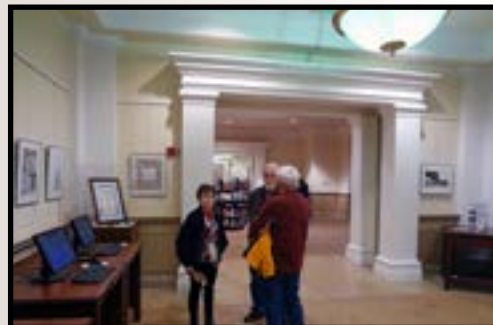

### Everything Old is News Again

Jim Jones was a reporter for the Fort Worth Star-Telegram from 1957-2018. He grew up in Bowie, Texas and graduated from high school there in 1975. Jones attended Arlington State College before transferring to North Texas State University. After he graduated in 1957, he was hired by the Star-Telegram where he covered obituaries, business feature stories, and the hotel at Chamber of Commerce beats. Jones briefly left the paper after less than a year to join the Air Force Reserve, where he was assigned to informatics services. He was honorably discharged in 1963, the same year that he was appointed Suburban Editor of the Star-Telegram. While covering the Mid-Cities, Jones explored his passion for local history by writing stories on interesting people and places in his regular column, "Here and There in Tarrant County." Jones also covered several big stories, including the assassination of John F. Kennedy and 1976 murder trial of Fort Worth oilman T. Cullen Davis.

Jones was fascinated by religion. Although he began writing about religion early in his career, it was not until 1978 that he was appointed religion editor of the Star-Telegram. In 1982, the Rockefeller Foundation awarded Jones a fellowship in religious studies for journalists at University of North Carolina, Chapel Hill. As an award-winning professional religion journalist, Jones covered international religion issues. He often wove travel in with religion to provide better understanding of issues. Though religious topics can be controversial at times, and Jones was known for his unbiased coverage of subjects such as the decades-long Southern Baptist Convention controversy between conservative, moderate, and liberal factions; the recent Episcopal Church schism; and the admission of a Muslim student into the Southwestern Baptist Theological Seminary.

During evaluation of the items in this archives collection the archivist observed a theme: many of the topics mentioned in Jones' papers are making news again: smoking, plastic bags, hate graffiti, claims of irresponsible journalism, and tragically, another mass shooting in a church.

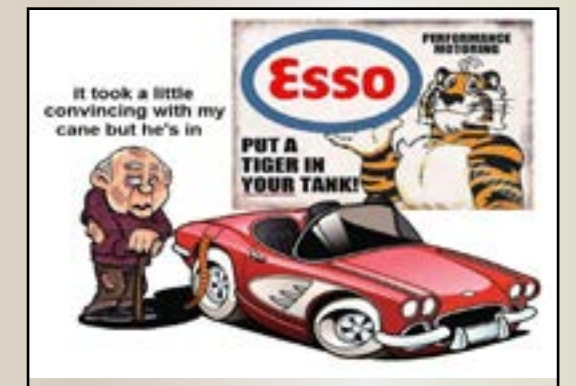

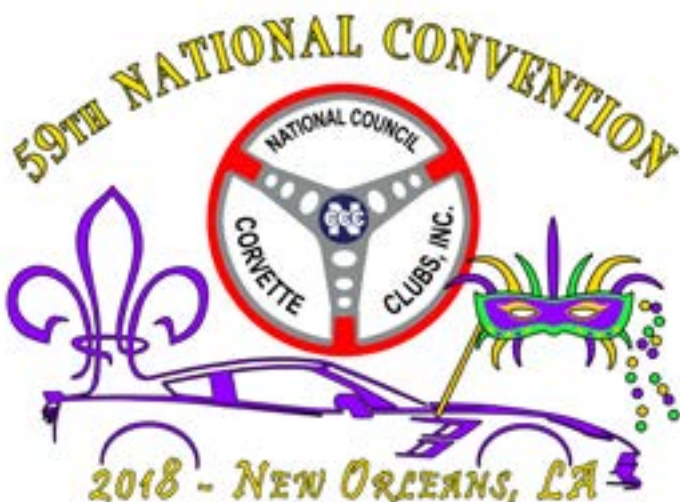
