



I want to take this time to say Thank You to all of our competitors and





So – have you thought about stepping up to be Cowtown's Webmaster? A reminder that this will be my last year; it has been fun and rewarding however I feel that it is time for someone else to step in and take over. If you have an interest I would welcome you to contact me. I'll be more than willing to share what the position entails and what I've learned during my time as webmaster. When I redesigned our website last year, I did make several design changes that makes the site easier to maintain; along with switching things over at the end/beginning of each year. I am sure that someone in our club has an interest and possess more skills in this area than me:)

**Social Media:** Do you have an interest for Social Media activities (Facebook in specific). If so, would you like to be on CTV's Social Media committee? For Facebook it is simple, when you post from a club or NCCC event, tag <u>Cowtown Vettes</u>; it is that simple. If <u>Cowtown Vettes</u> isn't on your friend list; send an invite.

We would also request special attention to what you post on social media; please DO NOT post photos of Vettes competing (at least racing) that might jeopardize the owner's insurance (i.e. sharing photos is fine – don't share ones with the license plate visible). For other aspects of the Social Media committee it involves scouring our website for faux pas, helping to set direction for the website and Facebook, and last but not least helping to shape our external communications / promotional documents.

**Photos:** We always welcome you to grab that

camera (or your smartphone) every time you head out with your Corvette. We can always use more and different styles / views of high-resolution photos for our website & newsletter. Please try to take your photos in the largest format and resolution that your camera and/or smartphone can capture. Hint: smartphone / tablet photos are typically marginal – unless you change the settings to the device's highest resolution. For any photo you provide, I take and resize them for use on the web along with the larger format for the Low-Down and the slideshows shared at our membership meetings. Your initials are added to the photos, to provide recognition to the photographer on each and every photo.

The club has a couple of dozen email distribution lists which are maintained by the webmaster. If you change your email address, mailing address, your Vettes, etc., please let membership know so that your information can be updated. If by chance you are not receiving the CTV-All emails then your correct email address must not be in the system; contact us. Send all email and mailing address updates to: <a href="mailto:ctv-membership@yahoogroups.com">ctv-membership@yahoogroups.com</a>.

NOTICE: When you are added to any distribution list, you will receive an email asking you to accept and join. You MUST accept it in order to be added to the distribution list; the invite (from yahoogroups) will time-out after several days, as well so don't delay.

In closing, please don't hesitate to shout if you have suggestions, questions or comments about YOUR Club's website, Facebook account or eMail distribution lists. Likewise if you find any pages that have issues or if there is something you would like to see or things you dislike. Remember, it is your website and it is Cowtown's image on the world-wide-web and it needs to be the best it can be.

#### **COWTOWN CRUISER**



The marker should include the name of the city, county or state that you wish to use if for. You can make your trip down the road not just a cruise, but also a history lesson. There are apps or websites to help you locate the markers when planning your cruises or you can just enjoy happening upon them. Also, county courthouses tend to be a bonanza of points with the county name, sometimes the city name, historical markers and veterans memorials. It still isn't too late to start! The 2018 Cruiser logo, rules and log sheets are available from the Cruiser Chairpersons, William Nolan or Mary Pittman. Daylight savings time kicks back in on March 11, giving that extra hour of daylight each day and hopefully it will be warmer by then, so get out and enjoy!
