



### **COWTOWN CRUISER**




How can it possibly already be August!!?? The year is flying by and it is HOT!! Summer's heat came early this year and has been relentless. Despite the fact that the air conditioner works

really well in our Corvette it still is not my favorite time of year for cruising, but who wants to sit at home, so crank up that air and go out for a ride there are still things to see and places to go.

Several of our members enjoyed their own cruises to and from the NCCC Convention in July to New Orleans, Louisiana sponsored by the Southwest Region. It was a great way to collect some of those out of state bonus points as well as points received for attending the convention itself. It was our first convention and an enjoyable experience.

There are about 3 and 1/2 months left to collect those cruiser points....I know that does not seem like much, but when you are starting with a clean slate it is easy to collect a bunch of points on your first time cruising around just our area. It has been mentioned that we maybe have not explained the cruiser program to the extent we should have. I think some times we forget that everyone hasn't been around forever. On the surface the program may look a little overwhelming, but it truly isn't. To me the easiest way to get a handle on it is to carefully read the rules sheet then ask specific questions on anything you might not understand in lieu of us trying to explain it all at once. The best way to stack up points is to either use historical markers on the categories they are allowed in and/or cruise out of state. It only takes 50 points for a bronze award....so get cruising.

If you aren't interested in collecting cruiser points, but you like to take pictures of your Corvette you can



still participate in the "What I Saw Along the Way" photo contest. Participants can submit 3 (4 **x 6) photos** of their Corvette in a scenic or unique setting. The photo contest will take place at the monthly meeting on November 2, 2018. Photos for that will need to be turned in to the cruiser chairperson prior to the start of the meeting at 7:30pm. We had some great photos last year and look forward to seeing many more this year.

There are currently no scheduled cruises. Hopefully when the weather cools down a bit someone will step up and plan an outing for our group. Just let us know and we will get it on the schedule for you and help out in any other way necessary.
