



COWTOWN CRUISER




This is the time of year when not only do the days start getting shorter, but also my articles do as well!!

The 100%er award was first conceived to encourage participation in the activities of the club and engage new members. Over the last several years, examination of the award winners reveals that the awards usually go to the same handful of people and not many new members have become active in the club solely because of the award.

To encourage more participation, the following changes are proposed to the awards program. This program, if approved, will replace the 100%er award and the Outstanding Male and Female member awards and will be the vehicle to determine the Rookie of the Year award.

The program will reward members for attendance at any CTV sponsored event - meetings, socials, cruises, and charity events - as well as revenue-generating events such as the TMS autocross, Mineral Wells autocross, Spring Scramble, and Car Show. There will be additional points for volunteering or entering one of the revenue-generating events as well as entering or volunteering at other NCCC events. Points will also be awarded for volunteer-

ing at the national races at Texas Motor Speedway which generates track dollars for the club. There will be a sign in sheet at all CTV Sponsored events. Proof of Attendance at other NCCC events (OKC, Waco, etc.) is the responsibility of the CTV member and must be turned in to the person keeping the points record.

Additional points will be awarded for volunteering to be a Committee chair. co-chair or committee member. There will also be points awarded for attending the NCCC National Convention.

Recognition will be given to all members who reach 150 points. Additional awards will be given to those who attain 250 points. The top 10 members who have the most points will be awarded as will the Rookie* with the highest number of points.

*A rookie is a member in his/her first full year of membership. In January every year, the Membership chair identifies all members who have joined in the previous year. These are identified as Rookies.

THE 6TH NATIONAL CORVETTE CARAVAN IS SLATED FOR AUGUST 28-31, 2019.

Often referred to as the world's largest moving automotive event, the National Corvette Caravan is a celebration of America's Sports Car, culminating in Bowling Green, Kentucky for the anniversary celebration of the National Corvette Museum. Hosted only once every five years, the next event is slated for Labor Day Weekend 2019 and will mark the Museum's 25th Anniversary. Leading the charge will be Jeffrey Duda of Hainesport, NJ, a Lifetime Member of the Museum and previous co-captain of the New Jersey 2014 and 2009 Caravans.

Regional caravans will form and join other caravans as they travel across the United States to meet in Bowling Green, Kentucky for four days of festivities at the National Corvette Museum. An event such as this requires years of planning and coordinating. All help is appreciated!




