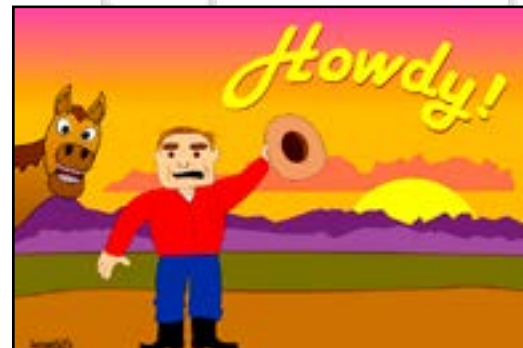

As this is being written we are having some of the coldest weather of the season....so hopefully by the time this is being read all that will just be a distant memory and we will be ready to enjoy some Corvette cruising.

Robert and Cydnie Geyer are planning a return trip to Nocona to see the cars at the Horton Classic Car Museum. This houses about 120 beautiful classic cars including quite a few Corvettes. The cars are the personal collection of Pete and Barbara Horton and are housed in a restored vintage building that once housed a car dealership. For those who choose to, this cruise will continue on up across the Red River into Oklahoma and the WinStar World Casino complex, where you can enjoy food and games of chance. From there you will be on your own for your return trip home so you can enjoy as much time as you choose at the casino. For those of you collecting cruiser points, there will be ample opportunities along the way to collect several counties, cities, 2 states and war memorials.

As a reminder, a cruiser photo should contain:

1. the CTV Cruiser logo,,
2. your Corvette,
3. yourself and of course,
4. the official designation of the location.

If you are using a historical marker to bump up your points total, the marker must also be visible in the photo....if it cannot be read from the distance it is also a good idea to take an up close picture of the marker.

It isn't too late to start collecting cruiser points. They can add up quite fast, especially if you are including historic markers in the categories that they can be used, or traveling out of state. The logo, log sheet and rules are available to download online or are available from the cruiser chairpersons at club meetings.



In the event that you are not interested in collecting cruiser points, but still like to photograph your Corvette, you can still participate in the CTV Cruiser Photo Contest, *"What I Saw Along the Way"*. Be on the lookout for interesting or unique settings in which to photograph your Vette. This could be a field of bluebonnets, a mountain or desert, an amazing sunrise or sunset or some curiosity that you happen upon along the road.

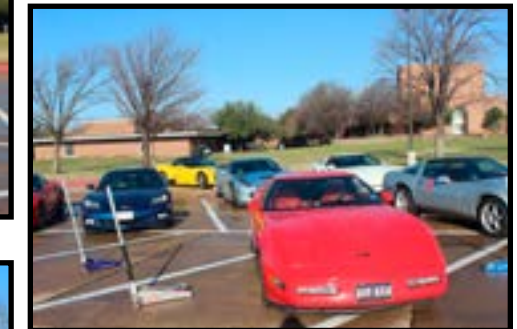

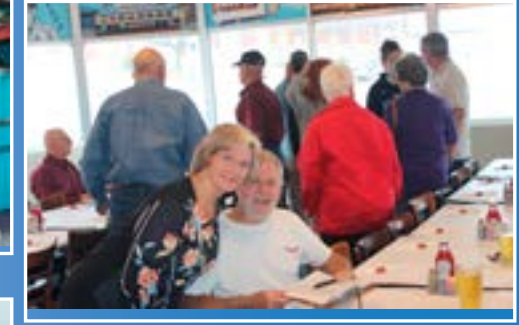

Corvette Experience at the NCM Motorsports Park!

Get behind the wheel of a Corvette Stingray Z51 for laps around our 3.15-mile road course, built for speed! You must be 18 years or older to participate with a valid driver's license. Participants must sign a Vehicle Damage Policy and Indemnity Agreement. You'll receive a combination of classroom instruction and hands-on practice on the track. Three 20-minute on-track sessions and three classroom sessions (alternating). The program also includes lunch and a guided VIP tour of the National Corvette Museum.

The Corvette Experience is open to the public and available for private events. Call ahead to schedule at 270-777-4509.

The **High Performance Drivers Introduction** is a "101" on track program introducing new drivers to the hobby of recreational performance driving.

Here's what it's about:

- Introducing new drivers to the recreational performance driving.
- Creating a lower cost, lower time commitment program to make it easier for drivers to give the sport a try.
- Breaking down the barriers of entry to the sport by keeping groups small, concentrated, and social.
- Creating more prepared drivers. In other words, demonstrating what to expect from a performance driving event as well as demonstrating what is needed and expected from a driver and their vehicle.
- In addition, it makes for a great car club or group activity!

So how does it work?

The premise of the program will be small, concentrated groups cycling between a Lead/Follow on-track program paired with classroom sessions on what to expect from performance driving events. In addition, it will be teaching basic technique and terms needed for success in performance driving.

Things covered in the On-Track curriculum:

- Basic car control



- Breaking down the corner – Turn In, Apex, Track Out
- Passing procedures and point-byes
- Corner Stations, Brake Markers, Pit In/Out signs
- Above all, having fun on track!

Things covered in the Classroom curriculum:

- Learning terms and procedures
- Vehicle tech requirements – What is needed from a vehicle?
- Personal protective equipment requirements

What equipment is required?

- Flags – Why are they there? What do they mean?
- Communicating with your instructor on and off the track
- Basic performance driving techniques
- How to get the most out of performance driving
