

COWTOWN CRUISER





NATIONAL CORVETTE MUSEUM

2019 C4 GATHERING MAY 16-18, 2019

Open to all those interested in the 4th Generation Corvette, these two organizations and the NCM are working to bring participants activities, seminars, road tours, MSP touring laps, and Karting along with information specific to their interest in this generation of Corvette.

Indianapolis 500

The 2019 Corvette Grand Sport will serve as the Official Pace Car for the 2019 Indianapolis 500 presented by Gainbridge, leading 33 drivers to the green flag on May 26 for the 103rd running of the legendary race. It marks the 16th time a Corvette has served as the Pace Car, starting in 1978, and the 30th time a Chevrolet has led the field dating back to 1948, when a 1948 Fleetmaster Six convertible paced the race. No other brand or vehicle has served as the 500 Pace Car more than Chevrolet and the Corvette, respectively.

Experimental Mid-Engine Corvette Now on Display

The XP-897 GT was a mid-engine concept Corvette intended to be the future generation of Corvette that would have been introduced in 1976. GM installed the Wankel Rotary engine as they planned rotary engines to replace standard piston-in-cylinder engines in future models of GM vehicles.



NASA Exhibit Welcomes Another Astronaut Corvette

The Museum now has two of the three Apollo 15 astronaut Corvettes on display as part of the Gas Station to Space Station exhibit. The three astronauts (David Scott, Al Worden and James Irwin) decided as a group to be patriotic with their Corvettes, with one Mille Miglia Red, one Classic White, and one Bridgehampton Blue. On top of the colors each had a double stripe placed down the length of the car, just to the left of the center, with the other two colors of the American flag. Added to the display is David Scott's Bridgehampton Blue Corvette.

The Denver club has put in the work so you can come and enjoy your time.


